GUIDELINES AND INSTRUCTIONS

Proposals for presentation of papers at the EASA 2025 conference will be:

- in the form of a 200-to-300-word abstract with
- a clear title of the presentation,
- author/s of the paper,
- an indication of the theme within which the paper should be considered and
- contact details of submitting presenter.
- Each delegate may only present a maximum of 2 papers.
- Abstract proposals will be considered on a continual basis.
- A detailed programme will be announced once it has been finalised.
- Only abstracts of delegates who paid the conference fee before 29 November 2024 will be included in the programme.

Delegates need to submit proof of payment on or before the due date, to ensure inclusion of their abstract in the Book of Abstracts and attendance/presentation at the conference.
